

SERIES OF LESSONS ON THE TABERNACLE:

PREVIEW

Sivan – 3rd month of the year (June) – encamped (Exo. 19:1-2) – wilderness of Sinai.

Abib – April – left Egypt – first month (Exo. 13:3-4)

Mt. Horeb – Mt. Sinai – the Mt. Of God

Moses – called through a burning bush (granite – compose of metallic properties).

Foot of Sinai – vast wilderness. In this mount the Lord made a covenant with Moses and his people (Exo. 19:5-8).

- how did the people know that God talked with Moses? When the Mountain is filled with thick clouds.
- Sinful men would always fear the voice of a Holy God.

In Ch. 24, Moses ascended Mt. Sinai for the second time.

- v. 16 – Moses went to the mount and the glory of God appeared.
- Heb. 12:29 – devouring fire – consuming fire
- 2 reasons why we should serve God:
 1. because we love should serve God:
 2. because he is a consuming fire.

* 40 days and nights – Moses stayed in Mt. Sinai – God gave him the two tablets of stones where the 10 commandments were written.

- Materials for the Tabernacle = were given by the people themselves. (Exo. 25:22)

- 3 major materials (v.3)

1. gold - Ch. 38
2. silver - Ch. 38:25
3. brass

Gold – 29 talents, 730 shekels = 2, 800 lbs. Of gold

Silver – 100 talents, 1775 shekels

Bronze – 70 talents, 2400 shekels
