Introduction:

Revival is a great work!

Message:

1. When the Christians believe and give consent that there is no revival.
 - a. Revival needs the labour of love and the prayer of faith.
 - b. Pessimism, negativism, and passivity
 - c. Men with negative attitude (EX. Judas)

2. When the Christians become uninvolved and irresponsible. We are God's ...
 - a. Workmanship – Eph. 2:10
 - b. Workmen – II Tim 2:15
 - c. Instruments – Romans 10:13-15
 - d. Servants
 - e. Ambassadors – II Cor. 5:20

3. When Christians get proud of their “great revival” (Prov. 15:26; 16:5)

4. When the Christians get tired by labours and trials (Gal. 6:9)

5. When Christians begin to proselyte than win souls (Psalm 126:5-6)

6. When Christians refuse to render to the Lord according to the benefits received (Psalm 116:12)

7. When the Christians grieve the Holy Spirit (Ephesians 4:30)

8. When the Christians lose the spirit of brotherly love (Romans 12:10; Heb. 13:1)

9. When Christians do not get frequently convicted, humbled and broken. (search me, humble me, break me)

10. When Christians will not practice self-denial (Matthew 16:24)

11. When Christians neglect the need of missions (Acts 1:8)

12. When Christians do not pray for labourers and surrender themselves to serve God (Matthew 9:36-38)

13. When Christians do not feel the need of being filled with the Holy Spirit (Eph. 5:18)
